During his 12 years at FedEx, he worked as European Controller and as a Managing Director in the Finance Division in Memphis, before returning to Europe as Vice President of FedEx's e-Commerce and Logistics business in Europe, Middle East and Africa where he directed the strategic and operational development of that division.

Francis is a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants, a Fellow of the Institute of Transport and Logistics and a Member of the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals. He participates actively in the Global Supply Chain Management Advisory Board at the Kenan Flagler Business School at University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill and is a Member of the Society of International Business Fellows (SIBF) in Atlanta. He speaks regularly on e-commerce and supply chain issues at conferences and universities. Mr. Francis will rejoin the Board of Opera Memphis where he served from 1992 to 1994.
